## 80 Years — A Look Back at our History

1950s: Small Space, Small Staff

In the 1950s we were called the Hawaii Territorial Employees' Federal Credit Union. At that time, there were only five credit union employees who provided services to Territorial government employee members and their spouses, helping about a dozen members on an average day. Addressograph and mimeograph machines were used to get notices out to members. These machines were kept in the hallway of the credit union's office in the basement of the Territorial Building because there was no space inside. If a member was seated inside the office and someone else wanted to come in, staff would have to ask the member to stand up so the other person could get through the door.
