Here's an excerpt from Malia Hall, age 67:

My father Jack Meek worked for the Department of Land and Natural Resources in the 50s, 60s and 70s in the Territorial Building. As a young girl I recall walking down the dark stairs to the dark basement of the credit union to give my savings account deposit to Mildred Texiera (shown in the February newsletter) standing behind the barred teller window. Years later, Mildred patiently helped me complete college loan applications. After completing college in California I returned home to Hawaii looking for employment. Lucky for me, the credit union hired me as a receptionist and I was soon promoted to a New Account Specialist.

My account with only four digits, opened all those years ago, remains open although I live in Boise, Idaho. It's my stash account for my visits home.
