New State of Hawaii Payroll System to Affect Direct Deposits

The State of Hawaii is in the process of implementing a new payroll system in 2018 that will allow their employees to access and update their payroll information through a self-service system known as the Hawaii Information Portal (HIP). State employee access to HIP will be rolled out in phases. For more information and the State of Hawaii rollout schedule, visit <http://ags.hawaii.gov/hawaiipay/schedule>.

State of Hawaii employees must use HIP to designate accounts for Direct Deposit to ensure no interruption of deposits into current HSFCU accounts. No action is needed until employees receive their official instructional letter and secure logon from the state.

Attention Retirees: NO ACTION is required of you.

The State of Hawaii has informed us that pension payments from the Employee Retirement System (ERS) are separate from the state's new payroll system and are not affected in any way.
