2019 Investing in Education Grant Program

Hawaii State FCU recognizes and appreciates the extraordinary effort and sacrifice Hawaii's public school teachers make to create the best classroom experience for their students.

The Investing in Education Grant Program provides funds for teachers in the State of Hawaii Department of Education to purchase much-needed supplies, books, furniture, electronics, equipment and other basic necessities for their classrooms.

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a member of Hawaii State FCU. If you are not a member, you may become a member before submitting an application.
- Applicant must currently be employed as a classroom teacher with the State of Hawaii Department of Education.

Application Requirements

- Applicant must complete a series of questions:
 - a) What are your classroom needs and why aren't there existing funds to obtain them?
 - b) What is your overall goal for these funds and how will it improve student learning?
 - c) Are these funds being used as part of a critical need in order to deliver instruction?
 - d) Include detailed information on the items to be purchased and their costs.
- School principal must review the teacher's application and verify the teacher's current employment at the school.

Education Grants (Up to \$500)

Grant recipients will be selected based on their application submissions. The dollar value of the grants will vary between \$200 and \$500 and will be determined individually based on the amount of funds requested. *(The full request amount must include all sales tax)*

Winners will be notified by mail, and grant money will be sent via check, made payable to the name of the school where the teacher works.

Grant recipients will be selected based on their essay submissions. The dollar value of each grant will vary between \$200 and \$500 and will be determined based on individual need. To be eligible for the Investing in Education Grant, the applicant must be both a classroom teacher in the Department of Education and a member of Hawaii State Federal Credit Union. Grant funds will be awarded on a first come, first served basis and will be awarded by December 31, 2019. Essay submissions are limited to one per teacher, per calendar year. All applications and essays must be submitted no later than 10/31/2019.
