A New Home for Hawaii State FCU

Dear Hawaii State FCU Members,

I am pleased to announce the beginning of a new and exciting development for Hawaii State Federal Credit Union. After 39 years, we have outgrown our Headquarters at 560 Halekauwila Street. Last month, we closed on the purchase of what will become the future Headquarters of Hawaii State FCU. The 10-story building, located at 333 Queen Street in Honolulu, will allow us to consolidate multiple office locations, eliminating the cost of leasing office space for our growing staff. The building has plenty of parking and this location will provide members easy access to all of our services, including those offered by investment and financial advisors, consumer and home loan experts, electronic banking specialists, business banking officers, and financial educators. Best of all, we will remain in close proximity to many state and city offices; in fact, our future Headquarters is less than two blocks away from our original 1936 offices – in the Territorial Office Building.

This new Headquarters is integral to Hawaii State FCU's long-term growth and mission to serve our members. As we renovate the space, we will incorporate new designs and technology to protect the health and safety of our employees and members in a post-COVID world. It is our hope that our Headquarters will embody our *always right by you* culture and allow us to continue our deep commitment to serving our members. While the building renovations will take some time, we will keep you informed of the progress and let members know when they can take advantage of this new facility.

In my message at the Annual Meeting, the word I used to describe our recent year was *growth*. And it's a very appropriate word now as well. Our hope is that this new Headquarters will allow Hawaii State FCU to continue to grow in all areas – to hire talented, hardworking staff, to provide more innovation, technology and convenience, and offer even more products and financial services for members. We are incredibly grateful for our members, and are glad to have you join us on this exciting journey.
