## Security In the Palm of Your Hand

At Hawaii State FCU, finding innovative ways to make your branch visits safe and more efficient is a priority. And one of the ways that we've been able to incorporate technology to create a better experience is through our use of palm vein biometric authentication, which allows our members to scan their palm for quick, secure access to their accounts.

By simply placing a hand over the scanner, the technology uses the unique vein patterns and blood flow in your hand to identify a member, allowing access to accounts without having to pull out identification. And contrary to popular belief, palm vein authentication does not collect or retain an actual image of your palm or finger prints.
